## **COMMUNITY EDUCATION COUNCIL DISTRICT 20 HAS A VACANCY FOR A PARENT MEMBER!**

New York City's Community Education Councils are charged with promoting student achievement, advising and commenting on educational policies, and providing input to the Chancellor and Panel for Educational Policy on matters of concern to the district. The powers and duties of CECs are spelled out in NYS Education Law §2590-e.

The responsibilities of CEC members include:

- ⇒ Approving zoning lines
- ⇒ Holding public hearings on the district's annual capacity plans
- ⇒ Submitting an annual evaluation of the superintendent to the Chancellor
- ⇒ Holding joint public hearings with the chancellor (or designee) for any proposed school closing or significant change in school utilization

*District 20* is in the southwest section of Brooklyn, spanning from the Verrazano Bridge to Borough Park and the southern section of Sunset Park. Neighborhoods include Bay Ridge, Dyker Heights, Bath Beach and Bensonhurst, along with the Fort Hamilton Army Base.

*The 9 Parent Members must have a student enrolled in grades kindergarten to 8<sup>th</sup> in a district school.*
