Reading CKLA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Explain that plants are living things. • Describe what plants need to live and grow: food, water, air, and light. • Explain that different kinds of plants grow in different environments and make its own food in its leaves. • Identify the root, stem, leaf, flower and seed of a plant.
Writing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I can, with prompting & support, identify the main topic and recall key details from a book about plants. • I can use a combination of drawing, dictating, and writing to compose informative/explanatory texts in which I name what is being written about and supply some information about the topic. • I can sort common objects into living and nonliving categories. • I can read and write my sight words correctly.
Fundations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I can review consonant and vowel sounds. • I can read and write CVC (consonant, vowel, consonant) words- ex. cat, mug, fox. • I can write capital letters correctly.



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Math: Chapter 6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I can use counting strategies to compare sets of objects. • I can compare two numbers and say what number is greater, less or equal. • I can write and read addition sentences. • I can add two numbers and write the sum. • I can understand addition as putting together and adding to, and understand subtraction as taking apart and taking from. • I can count to tell the number of objects.
Science: Plants	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I can explain that seeds are the beginning of new plants. • I can explain the basic life cycle of plants.
Social Studies: Unit 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What makes a community? • Reviewing the Seven Habits.

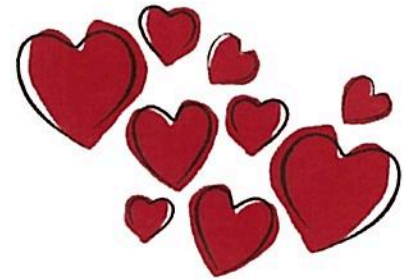
