<p>Reading: CKLA: Kings and Queens + Seasons and Weather</p>	<p>With prompting and support, I can ask and answer questions about unknown words in a text. With prompting and support, I can ask and answer questions about key details in a text. I can identify kings and queens, what they wear, and what their jobs are. I can make cultural connections to text and self. I can recall facts about the four seasons. I can describe the weather.</p>
<p>Writing: Narrative</p>	<p>I can use a combination of drawing, dictating, and writing to compose a text to self-connection. I can organize and tell the sequence of events (first, next, last). I can read and write my sight words correctly. I can complete a sentence with a capital at the beginning, a finger space between words, and punctuation at the end.</p>
<p>Fundations : Unit 3&4</p>	<p>I can review consonant sounds and vowel sounds. I can tap, blend, and sound out CVC words. I can say short and long vowel sounds. I can identify and say digraph sounds.</p>
<p>Math: Chapter 9</p>	<p>I can identify and name the following shapes: circle, hexagon, triangle, square, and rectangle. I can name the shapes that have a curve, vertices, and sides. I can count how many vertices and sides a shape has. I can compare two-dimensional shapes.</p>



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Science: Animals	I can identify living and nonliving things. I can compare living and nonliving things. I can identify the needs of living things.
Social Studies: Maps	I can identify people and places on a map. I can identify my school, community, or neighborhood on a map. I can describe what makes up a community.
