June Learning Targets

Reading/Read Aloud Stories	I can describe the connection between two individuals, events, ideas, or pieces of information in a text and identify the reasons an author gives to support points in a text. I can make connections between self, text, and the world around me.
Writing: Informational	I can check my writing using the writing checklist (capitals, finger space, and punctuation). I can add three details to my informational writing to supply readers with facts! I can respond to questions and suggestions from peers and add details to strengthen writing as needed.
Fundations: Unit 5	I can continue to practice reading and writing words with digraphs (ck, wh, sh, ch, th). I can practice scooping (or grouping) words together when I am reading so that I can read fluidly. (The <i>opposite</i> of scooping phrases together would be reading like a robot and adding pauses between words)

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Math: <i>Chapter 11& 12</i>	I can describe measurable attributes of objects, such as length and weight. I can classify objects into categories and count the objects (working with graphs).
Science: <i>Sunlight and Weather</i>	I can communicate ideas and obtain information about different types of weather(cause and effect). I can analyze data from illustrations of weather to describe the effects of weather (cause and effect).
Social Studies: <i>Geography People and the Environment</i>	I can understand that: 1. Families change over time 2. Families recount events using sequence words (first, yesterday, last year, etc.) 3. Family history can be shared (names, family trees, letters, old photographs, etc.) 4. Families have a cultural heritage. 5. Families have traditional foods/recipes that reflect their culture.
