Instructional Plan

Teachers will be responsible for providing standard-based lessons through this remote learning period and communicate clear expectations to students and families. Students are required to complete instructional activities in the timeline provided.

- All grades K-8 teachers are using google classrooms or google site for each class. Teachers will assign lesson plans and tasks for students. Students will be notified how to access google classroom and google site to complete and submit their daily tasks.
- Grades K-2 will be using Compass learning platform and provide various resources for students to use based on lessons they are assigned.
- Grades 3-8 will be using google classroom platform. Teachers will post lessons in all subjects.
- All students who requested technology and/or Wi-Fi will be receiving a device through Friday, March 20th, 2020. Please contact your child's teacher for further information.

This is our new normal Families! Team 30 is prepared, with all hands on deck, to support our students and families through these concerning times. We would like this transition to be as comprehensive as possible, where each child knows that teachers and staff are available and ready to teach and support just as we do when they are in the building.

Social Emotional Learning (SEL) Plan

- Our school counselors, deans, social workers, and advisory teachers will be available to support students using tele-therapy. Related service providers will also have a google classroom site and will be contacting students for sessions.
